**Confidentiality:**

In the course of volunteering with PRM, volunteers may receive and become aware of confidential information pertaining to PRM or its clients, employees, donors or volunteers. Volunteers of PRM are responsible for protecting the privacy of PRM clients, volunteers, employees, and donors. It is imperative that all volunteers refrain from disclosing any client information, either directly or indirectly, verbally or in writing to anyone, including media outlets. Further, volunteers are expected to safeguard confidential and personal information related to PRM donors, employees, and other volunteers. At no time or in no manner, either directly or indirectly, should a volunteer divulge, sell, disclose, communicate, or use confidential information.

- 1. Client/Resident Information: All client/resident information is confidential and is not to be disclosed outside of appropriate personnel within Pueblo Rescue Mission.
- 2. Donor Information: All donor lists and information, whether personal or financial, are confidential and are the property of PRM.
- 3. Volunteers/Employees: Information related to PRM volunteers and employees, other than what is publicly available, shall not be disclosed to third parties or used for personal use.
- 4. Financial Business and Operations: Information pertaining to PRM business that has not been made public shall remain confidential.

**Photo & Video Release:**

I grant PRM the right to use my likeness and voice in videos or still photos to promote/inform the public about PRM. The permission includes all remakes and reissues with regard to promotion, advertising and marketing. I understand that I have the right to make arrangements with the photographer at any PRM event to ensure my image or likeness is not used.
